

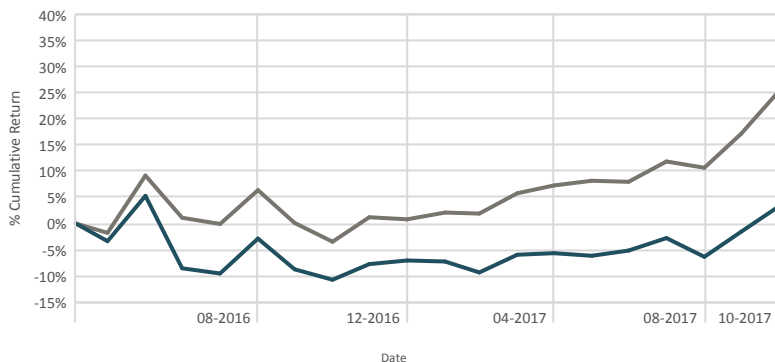
**+ INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE**

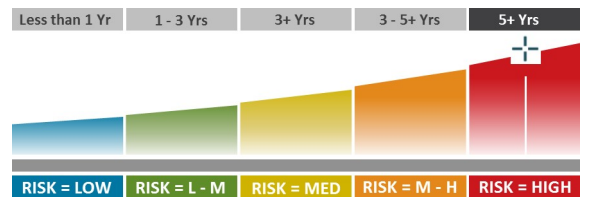

**High Risk**
