

INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE

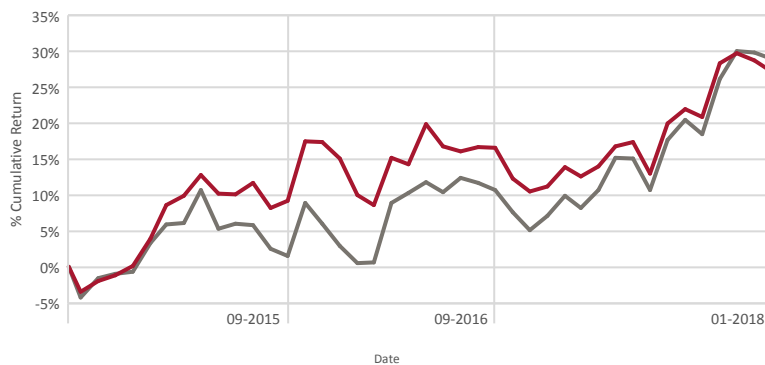

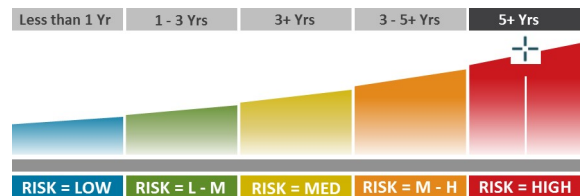

High Risk
