Fund Objective

The ABSA Access BCI Stable Fund objective is to preserve capital over the medium to long term with potential for some capital growth.

The portfolio is managed according to the guidelines as set out in Regulation 28 of the Pension Fund Act and is suitable for pension fund investment selection.

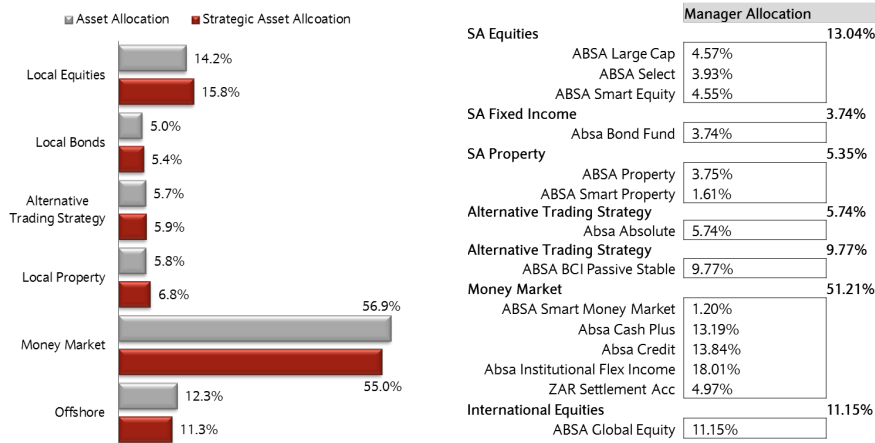
The composition of the portfolio shall reflect the investment structure of a retirement fund with a conservative risk profile therefore the portfolio's equity exposure will be limited to maximum 25% of the portfolio's net asset value. In order to achieve its objective, the investments normally to be included in the portfolio may comprise a combination of assets in liquid form, money market instruments, interest bearing securities, bonds, debentures, corporate debt, equity securities, property securities, preference shares, convertible equities, convertible debentures and non-equity securities. The portfolio may from time to time invest in listed and unlisted financial instruments. The manager may include forward currency, interest rate and exchange rate swaps transactions.

Fund Strategy

The fund will actively allocate between assets classes to achieve the objective based on thorough quantitative and qualitative analysis.

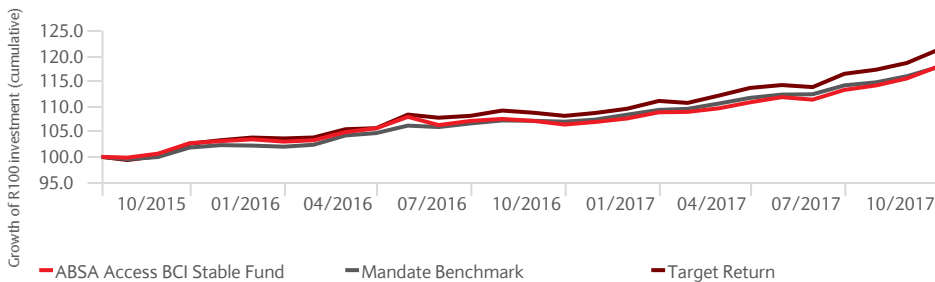
