

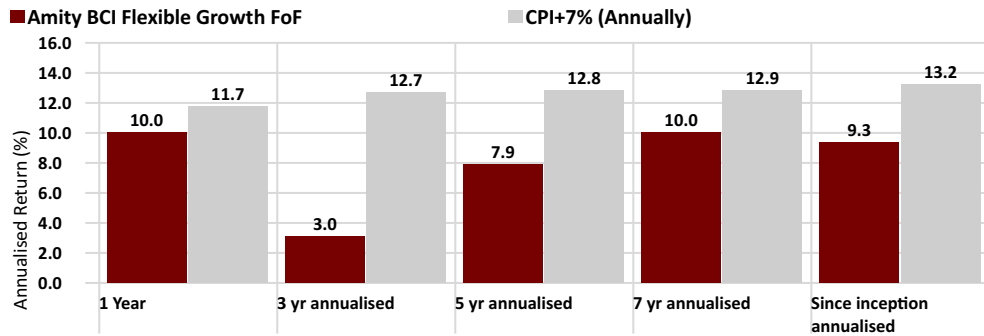

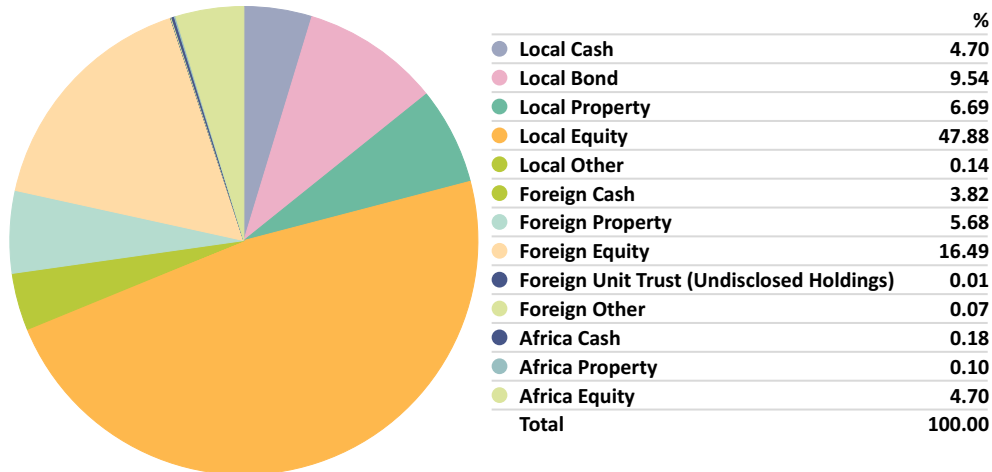

INVESTMENT STRATEGY

The underlying portfolios of collective investment schemes will be registered in South Africa or other similar schemes operated in territories with a regulatory environment which is to the satisfaction of the manager and trustee of a sufficient standard to provide investor protection at least equivalent to that in South Africa and which is consistent with the portfolio's primary objective. The Manager shall have maximum flexibility in terms of asset allocation and shall not be precluded from continually varying the underlying exposure to equity securities, non-equity securities, bonds, preference shares, property and money market portfolios and assets in liquid form.
