

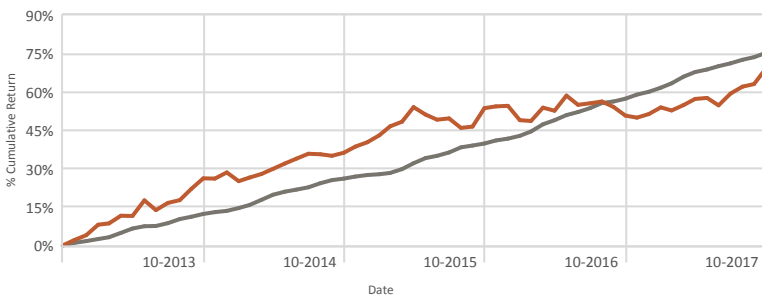
INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE

The investment objective of the Caleo BCI Worldwide Opportunities Fund of Funds is to maximise long term total returns by identifying and investing in local and global investment opportunities with a "value bias".

INVESTMENT UNIVERSE

Investments to be included in the portfolio will, apart from assets in liquid form, consist of participatory interests in portfolios of collective investment schemes investing in equity securities, property shares, property related securities, non-equity securities, bonds, preference shares, interest bearing securities and money markets instruments. The underlying portfolios of collective investment schemes will be registered in South Africa or other similar schemes operated in territories with a regulatory environment which is to the satisfaction of the manager and trustee of a sufficient standard to provide investor protection at least equivalent to that in South Africa and which is consistent with the portfolio's primary objective.

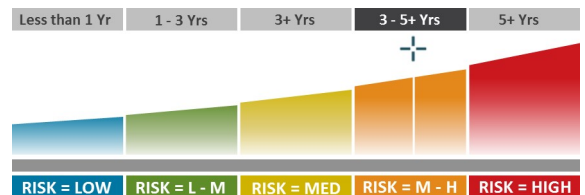

Medium - High Risk
