The Cinnabar BCI Balanced Fund of Funds aims to deliver a moderate to high long term total return.

+ INVESTMENT UNIVERSE

The portfolio will be managed in compliance with prudential investment guidelines for retirement funds in South Africa to the extent allowed for by the Act, with a maximum equity exposure of 75% of the portfolio's asset value. Investments to be included in the portfolio will, apart from cash, consist of participatory interests and other forms of participation of local and global collective investment schemes, or other similar schemes operated in territories with a regulatory environment which is to the satisfaction of the manager and trustee of a sufficient standard to provide investor protection at least equivalent to that in South Africa and which is consistent with the portfolio's primary objective, investing in equity securities, property securities, non-equity securities, money market instruments, preference shares, bonds and other interest bearing instruments and securities.

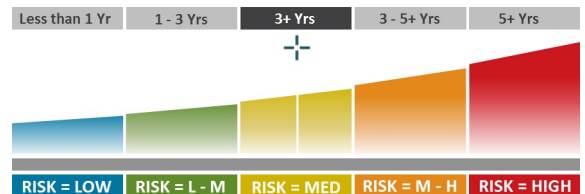

Medium Risk
