

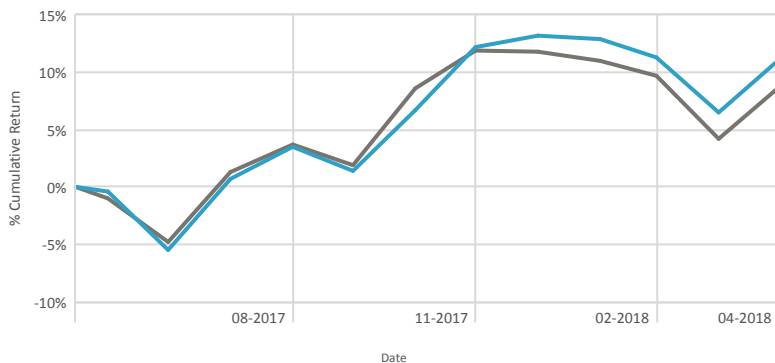
### INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE

The portfolio's investment universe consists of equity securities, preference shares, property shares and property related securities listed on exchanges, money market instruments and assets in liquid form. The portfolio's equity exposure will always exceed 80% of its net asset value. The portfolio may from time to time invest in listed and unlisted financial instruments. The manager may include the following unlisted financial instruments: forward currency, interest rate and exchange rate swap transactions.

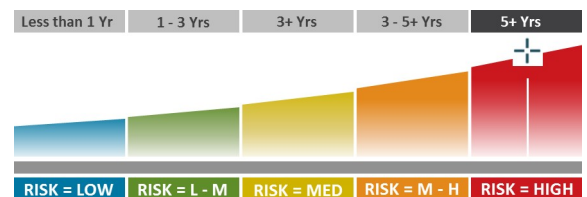

#### High Risk
