

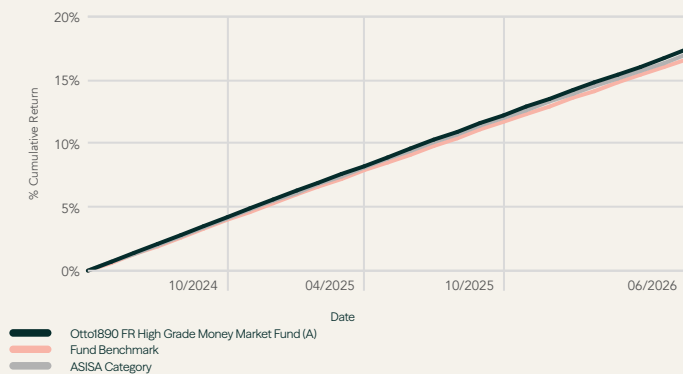
### Investment Objective

The investment objective is to provide a medium whereby investors can obtain undivided participation in a diversified portfolio of money market instruments and assets in liquid form.

### Investment Approach

The Otto1890 FR High Grade Money Market Fund is a local money market portfolio. The primary performance objective of the portfolio is to obtain as high a level of current income as is consistent with preservation and liquidity. Capital gains will be of an incidental nature. The portfolio predominantly invests in investment grade assets of issuers that demonstrate high levels of effective governance in their operating model. The portfolio is managed in compliance with prudential investment guidelines for retirement funds in South Africa as well as in compliance with the Medical Schemes Act's investment guidelines to the extent allowed for by the Act.

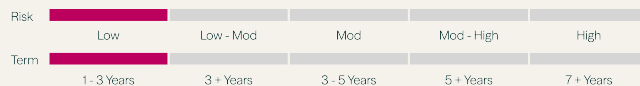

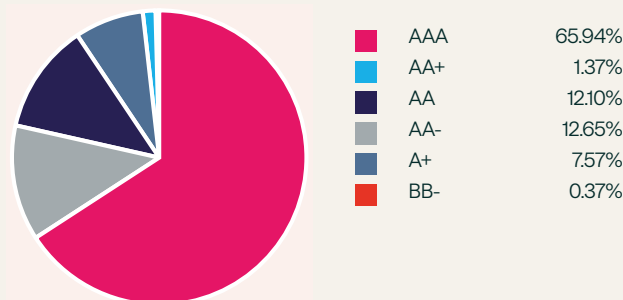
