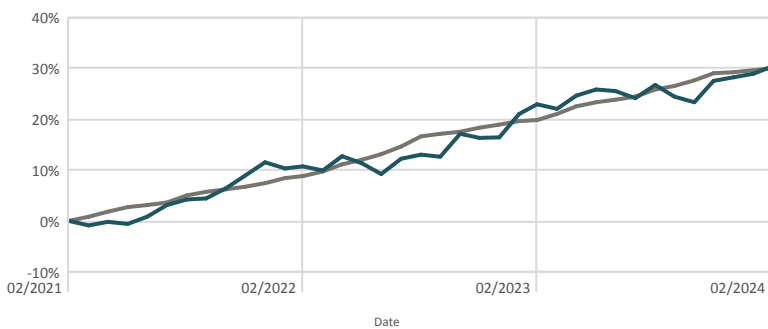
INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE

The Pyxis BCI Worldwide Flexible Fund is a worldwide flexible portfolio that aims to deliver a high long-term total return.

INVESTMENT POLICY

The portfolio may invest in global and local equity securities, interest bearing securities, property shares, property related securities, preference shares, money market instruments, non-equity securities and assets in liquid form. The portfolio may also invest in participatory interests and other forms of participation in portfolios of collective investment schemes. The portfolio may from time to time invest in listed and unlisted financial instruments. The manager may also include forward currency, interest rate and exchange rate swap transactions for efficient portfolio management purposes. Manager internal asset allocation restriction: maximum 60% equity exposure

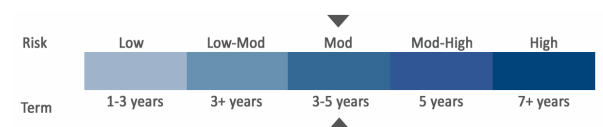

Moderate Risk

- This portfolio has a balanced exposure to various asset classes. It has more equity exposure than a low risk portfolio but less than a high-risk portfolio. In turn the expected volatility is higher than a low risk portfolio, but less than a high-risk portfolio.
- Where the asset allocation contained in this MDD reflect offshore exposure, the portfolio is exposed to currency risks.
- The portfolio is exposed to equity as well as default and interest rate risks.
- The portfolio is suitable for medium term investment horizons.
- The probability of losses is higher than that of a low risk portfolio, but less than a high-risk portfolio and moderate long term investment returns are expected.
