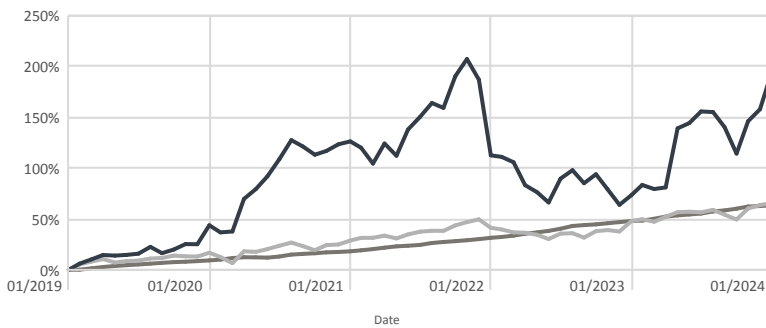
### INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE

The Raven BCI Worldwide Flexible Fund is a worldwide multi-asset flexible portfolio which aims to deliver a high long term total return.

### INVESTMENT POLICY

The manager shall have the maximum flexibility to vary assets between the various markets, asset classes and countries to reflect the changing economic and market conditions. It may invest in global and local equity securities, interest bearing securities, property shares, property related securities, preference shares, money market instruments, non-equity securities and assets in liquid form. The portfolio may also invest in participatory interests and other forms of participation in portfolios of collective investment schemes. The portfolio may from time to time invest in listed and unlisted financial instruments. The manager may also include forward currency, interest rate and exchange rate swap transactions.

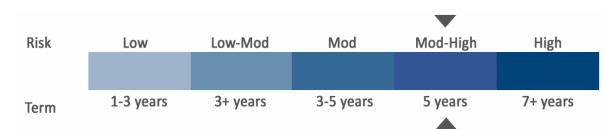

### Moderate - High Risk

- This portfolio holds more equity exposure than a medium risk portfolio but less than a high-risk portfolio.
