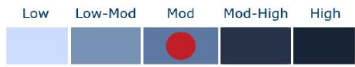

Investment Objective

The Southern Charter FR Balanced Fund of Funds is a moderate managed fund of funds. The primary investment objective of the portfolio is to provide the investor with a moderate total return. The Fund aims to provide investors with capital growth above inflation over the longer term by investing in a combination of asset classes including local and international equities, fixed interest, property and cash. As the Fund has a medium allocation growth assets, it is ideal for investors with a medium investment horizon, who seek capital growth and who are at least 5 - 10 years from retirement. The fund is Regulation 28 compliant.

Strategy

The Fund is actively managed with a value bias. By focusing on macro themes, the Fund looks to exploit valuation discrepancies in asset classes when they occur. The allocation to equities will range from 40% to 60%, depending on economic conditions with neutral weighting of 55%. The balance is allocated to the other asset classes. The allocation to assets other than equities, aims to reduce the risk of capital loss in the portfolio.

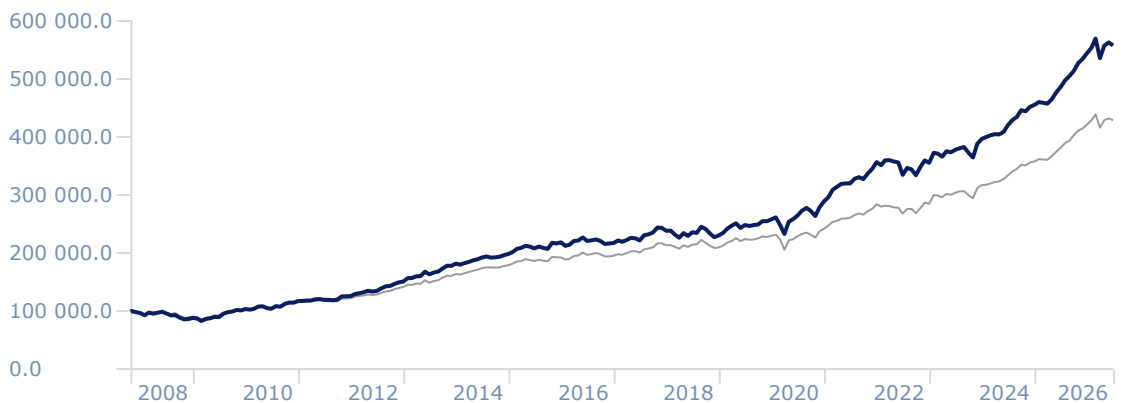

Growth of R100 000 (Since Inception)

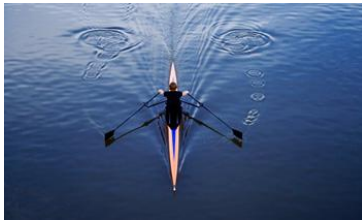

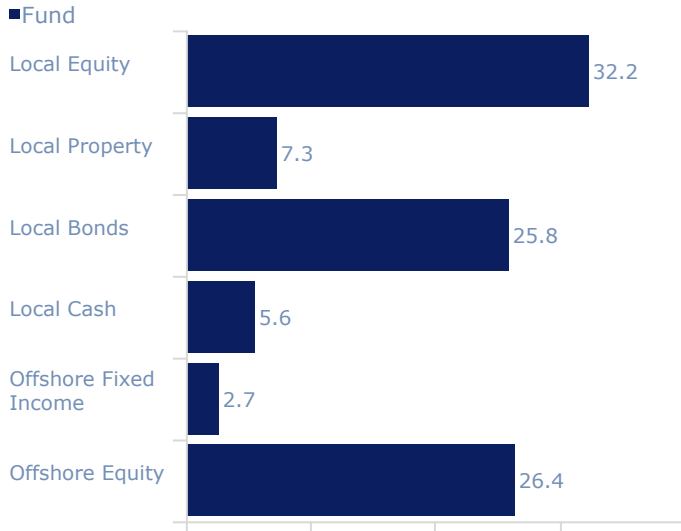

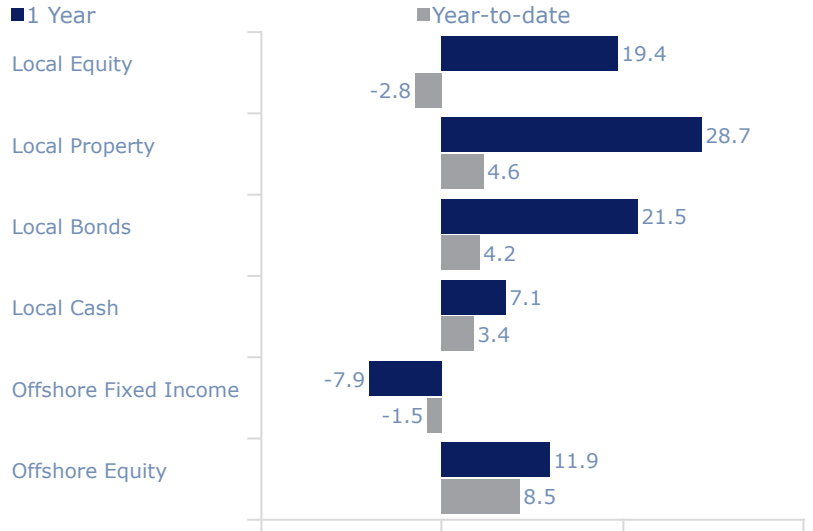

Asset Allocation (%)

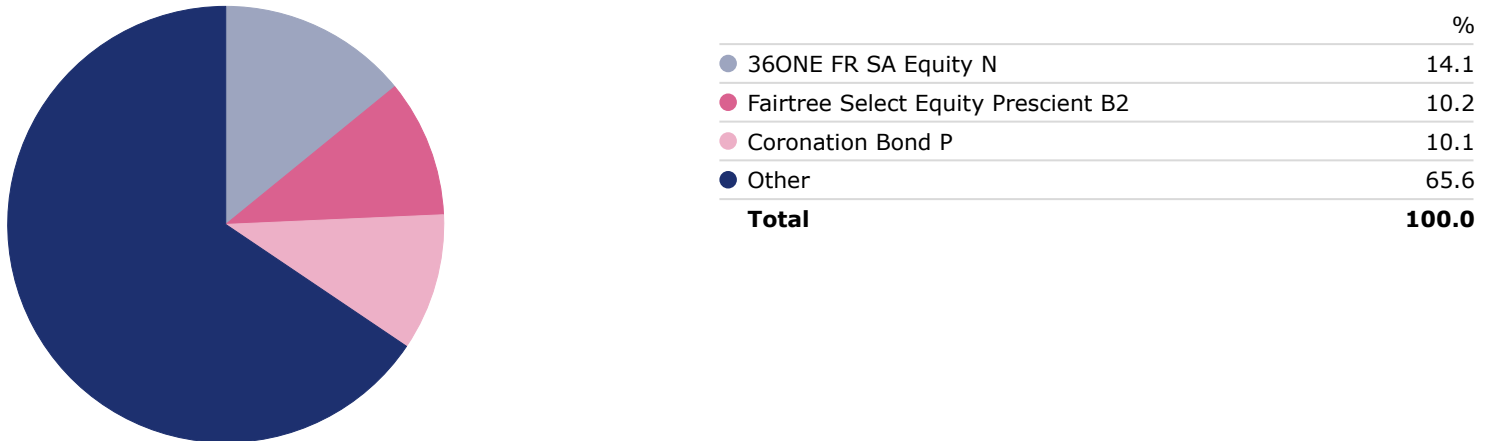


Asset Class Performance (% ZAR)

Medium Risk

This portfolio has a balanced exposure to various asset classes. It has more equity exposure than a low risk portfolio but less than a high-risk portfolio. In turn the expected volatility is higher than a low risk portfolio, but less than a high-risk portfolio.
